GRADES 1-8

- Pencil case (obligatory)

- Book covers for all their non-consumable books: paper bags work best. **Contact paper or any adhesive-backed** book covers are not allowed as book covers. Students cannot write or mark up books.
- Lunch bag (lunches cannot be put in school bags)
- Felt tip pens and hi-liters are not allowed
